- Need for training data
- More realistic tasks (medical)
- Challenging data set (medical)
 - French, English, mixed and empty datasets
 - Abbreviations (non standard), spelling errors, incomplete phrases
 - Very varied set of images in JPEG, different resolution and quality



Our goals

- 2004: Combine textual and visual retrieval
 - Goal was reached as there were several mixed submissions
 - Hope to foster cooperation between visual and textual groups at the event (complementary approaches)
- 2005: Optimise textual/visual retrieval
 - This year's data can be training data
 - Attract more machine learning techniques
 - Query dependent optimisation?
- 2006: region-based querying, real world tasks



Data sets

- Getting data for image retrieval evaluation is hard
- Stop the St. Andrews collection (?)
- Getty images, Corbis data sets available
 - Terms and conditions are important
- Web retrieval task, multi-lingual
- IRMA dataset: 10.000 medical images for classification (annotated with four axis code)
- National Library of Medicine (NLM)
- Larger number of medical images together with casimage
 - MIRC (medical image resource centre, RSNA), OHSU



Tasks in imageCLEF

- Web retrieval task on images
- Colour image retrieval task similar to St. Andrews (getty, corbis)
- Medical image retrieval task will be continued
 - Image classification subtask
 - Textual image description
- Interactive imageCLEF?
 - Integrate into iCLEF
 - User interface comparison
 - Query speed
